A RESOLUTION OF THE MILLERSBURG BOROUGH COUNCIL, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CREATING A 90-DAY TRIAL PERIOD FOR ERECTING A STOP SIGN IN THE VICINTY OF BOYD STREET AND NORTH STREET

WHEREAS, the Millersburg Borough Council recognizes a traffic control and safety hazard exists at the intersection of Boyd Street and North Street due to vehicles moving rapidly along North Street heading West; and

WHEREAS, the Millersburg Borough Council was approached by multiple concerned citizens requesting action be taken to mitigate the issue; and

WHEREAS, the Millersburg Borough Council has the authority under Chapter 15 Motor Vehicles and Traffic, 15-105 Experimental Regulations to enact a trial period for safety measures. The trial period will be in effect from Feb. 16 hours 16 hours.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the following traffic control device shall be erected for a 90-day trial period:

Corner of Boyd and North

Stop sign for westbound traffic on North Street

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Millersburg Borough Council establishes a 90-day trial period for erecting a traffic control and safety device in the area of Boyd Street and North Street.
