12/9/1864		Declaring the lands owned by F. Herrich & Co. (late Philip Dougheil) including the Oak Hill Cemetery as part of the territory of Millersburg.
3/6/1865		Bringing in the Freeland Farm and Musser's out lot. This refers to lands owned by James Freeland in Upper Paxton Township and S. Musser lands adjoining the Freeland property.
3/23/1865		Bringing within the Borough limits N. G. Frick & Co. sawmill.
1/3/1870		Declaring all the lands owned by H. B. Hoffman to be a part of the territory comprising the Borough.
10/3/1870		Declaring all the lands of A. Douden, George Lebo, J.R. Johns and William Zimmerman, as a part of the territory comprising the Borough.
2/5/1872		Declaring all the lands of the Union Burial Ground Association, as part of the territory comprising the Borough.
12/7/1875		Declaring all the lands of Dr. Samuel Stites, as part of the territory comprising the Borough.
11/8/1882		Declaring all the land of William H. Musser, as part of the territory comprising the Borough.
10/1/1883		Declaring all the land of Jonathan Frank, situate on Race Street, as part of the territory comprising the Borough.
9/7/1885		Declaring all the land of Daniel Martz on Race Street and the land of Joseph Kramer on the corner of Front and Moore Streets, as part of the territory comprising the Borough.
1/4/1908		Authorizing that a certain tract of land, lying adjacent to the Borough, on the east, shall be deemed, and taken and allowed to be a part of said Borough. (This annexed "East End Addition.")

12/15/1925		Annexing to the Borough, a portion of Upper Paxton Township, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, adjoining and adjacent to said Borough.
6-1929	12/17/1929	Declaring the admission of a section of Upper Paxton Township, adjacent to the Borough, to be known as the Fifth Extension of the Borough; fixing the grades of streets and alleys contained in said Section and providing that the grading of said streets and alleys shall be done by the owners before they are accepted as public highways by the Borough.
