Agr. 12/10/1981		Entering into an agreement between the Millersburg Fire Company No. 1 and the Borough concerning: fire protection to the Borough with a sum of \$10,000 annually for a term of 7 years beginning January 1, 1982 for the use of such company, and restrictions for said money to be used; construction for a new carriage house is to start before the specified time and provide to the Borough, upon written request, documents relating to the construction; make available to Borough officials financial records/reports relating to the Fire Company; and in the case that the said company is unable to function for some reason, the Borough and the Upper Paxton Township shall be entitled to immediate possession of the properties of the Fire Company.
Agr. 4/8/1982		Entering into an agreement between the Borough and the Millersburg Area Pool Association in which the Borough is having the Pool Association continue to maintain and operate the swimming pool under the responsibilities listed by the Borough.

Res. 4/8/1982		Terminating the assignment of lease between the Millersburg Area School District, Borough and Swimming Pool Association and keep in force all conditions of the original lease between the Millersburg Area School District and the Borough.
Res. 12/13/1984		Providing for the furnishing of electric street lighting service to the Borough by Pennsylvania Power and Light Company.
Agr. 12/8/1988		Entering into an agreement between the Millersburg Fire Company No. 1 and the Borough and the Township of Upper Paxton concerning: fire protection to the Borough and the Township with a sum of \$12,000 each annually for the term of 4 years in quarterly installments of \$3,125 due on or before March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31, and the first payment due on March 31, 1989, is in addition to Workman's Compensation and fire hydrant rental; the said money is to be used for the sole purpose of debt reduction of the carriage house, after the retirement or completion of debt reduction, the residue moneys are to be used for maintenance; make financial records/reports relating to the Fire Company available to the Borough and Township; requests the Fire Company provide a Report of Audit of the Fire Company annually within 90 days after the close of the fiscal year; must notify the Borough and the Township of any purchase that exceeds \$20,000; in the case that the Fire Company is unable to function for any reason, the Borough and Township shall be entitled to immediate possession of the facilities, properties and assets; 14 months prior to the expiration of this agreement, the Fire Company must advise in writing the approximate amount the Borough and the Township would be requested to pay for fire protection services after this agreement has expired; and this agreement shall begin on January 31, 1989, and shall continue in full force until December 31, 1992.
Res. 12/8/1988		Entering in the proposed agreement between Millersburg Fire Company No. 1 and the Borough and Upper Paxton Township for fire protection to the Borough and the Township.
Res. 10/12/1989		Providing for the furnishing of electric street lighting service to the Borough by Pennsylvania Power and Light Company.

Res. 12/14/1995B		Entering into an agreement between Millersburg Fire Company No. 1 and the Borough and Upper Paxton Township concerning fire protection to the Borough and the Township in which both municipalities agree to adopt a fire tax ordinance in the amount of 1 mill on the assessed valuation of real estate within the respective municipalities. The proceeds of this tax will be forwarded to the Treasurer of the Fire Company. The Fire Company agrees that 35% of the funds that it receives from the Borough and the Township shall be set aside in a special capital investment fund and that any expenditure from this fund shall have the approval of the Fire Company, the Borough and the Township. All Workmen's Compensation Insurance and fire hydrant rental will be paid by the Borough and the Township. As part of this agreement the Fire Company agrees to make available for inspection by the Borough and Township officials, at least annually, all financial records and reports relating to the Fire Company. The Borough, Township and Fire Company agree that the Fire Company will provide to the Borough and the Township each year, within 90 days after the close of its fiscal year, a report of audit performed by three auditors, one appointed by each entity. In the event of dissolution, liquidation, receivership, insolvency or bankruptcy of the Fire Company the Borough and the said Township shall be entitled to immediate possession of the equipment, facilities, property and all assets of the Fire Company so as to assure a ready response to any emergency call. During the term of this agreement the Fire Company will not charge rent to the Millersburg Ambulance Association for the housing of their equipment in the fire house located in the Borough. This agreement shall commence on January 1, 1996, and shall continue in full force and effect for a period of 10 years until December 31, 2006.
