**RESOLUTION NO. 18-10**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PASSAGE OF SB 1099**

**WHEREAS**, the system for collection of real estate taxes in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is entrusted to elected Tax Collectors; and

**WHEREAS**, municipalities often face vacancies in the office of Tax Collector; and

**WHEREAS**, current state law allows municipalities to deputize the County Treasurer to perform tax collection in certain circumstances; and

**WHEREAS**, Millersburg Borough has had occasion to deputize the Dauphin County Treasurer for collection of local real estate taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, Millersburg Borough has found that the arrangement with the Dauphin County Treasurer results in efficient tax collection and reduced costs; and

**WHEREAS**, Pennsylvania Senate Bill No. 1099 would allow, but not mandate, municipalities to eliminate the elected Tax Collector position and appoint the County Treasurer as the municipal Tax Collector; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the opinion of the Millersburg Borough Council and Borough staff that the County Treasurers' Offices are able to efficiently and cost effectively provide tax collection services;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Millersburg Borough Council supports SB 1099 and the policies contained therein, and


